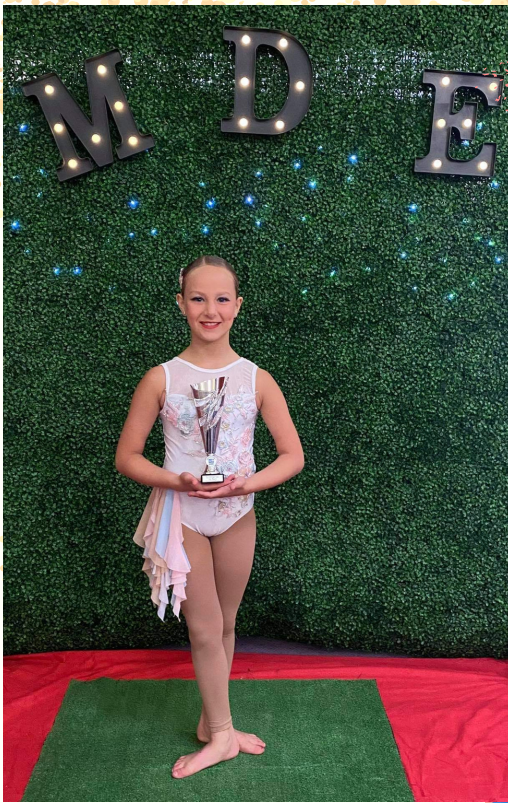
Mental Health Workshop
