What is Ready Set Dance?

A 1 hour combination class of JAZZ, TAP (Level 2), HIP HOP, SINGING, MUSIC and a whole lot of fun with our break dancing mascot, Freeze!



What is Ready Set Ballet?

A 30 minute magical ballet experience! Twirl (our mascot) will lead our little dancers through each step of the class as they learn the fundamentals of ballet.



What is Ready Set Acro?

A 30 minute acrobatic class, specifically designed for preschoolers. It emphasises safe and effective progressions to foster the physical and social skills needed for healthy early childhood development.



FAQ'S



Can I watch my child's classes?

In our experience, preschoolers are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and siblings. Our program has been endorsed by leading child care experts who support the independent learning model. As preschoolers participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness. We have multiple performance opportunities throughout the year, including our 'special theme' weeks & annual showcases. Having said that, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. Our program allows parents to watch the first class if necessary to help them adjust.

Are your teacher's qualified?

All teachers have their Working with Children Check and follow the program that is endorsed by early learning experts. READY SET DANCE teachers are required to gain their accreditation from READY SET DANCE head office before delivering the program, as well as a national accreditation for Certificate IV in Dance Teaching and Management. Reflections staff members are also accredited with First Aid, CPR & 'Keeping Kids Safe in Dance' certificates.

Do we need to purchase uniform and shoes?

Students must wear the READY SET DANCE / Tiny Tumblers uniform. However, we need to make sure we are the right fit for you and your child before committing to anything. Comfortable clothes and sneakers are fine for the first couple of lessons. Once your child has settled you can purchase the official READY SET DANCE and Tiny Tumbler uniform at reception which we are sure you will love.

If we miss a class can it be made up on another day of the week?

You may swap days during Terms 1, 2 and 3 if you miss a class (as long as the make up class is not full). In term 4, each class works on a different routine for the end-of-year concert, and it is too confusing for students to be swapping days. We do recommend that you avoid alternating days too much as preschoolers need the comfort of knowing that the same teacher and their friends will be there when they go to dancing.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

UNIFORMS

Compulsory uniform items are available for sizing and purchase at reception. Appropriate shoes are required for every class within 2 weeks of enrollment.

PAYMENT

Term fees are to be paid in full prior to your child's first class, or scheduled on a direct debit payment plan (via Payrix- to be set up upon enrolment). A \$5 late fee will be applied per week after after this date. Payrix payment options are monthly payments, fortnightly payments or weekly payments. If your account should reach 3 FAILED Payments, this option will no longer be available, all Term Fees will need to be paid upfront, in full, with the office.

EXTRA CHARGES: (compulsory for performances)

TERM 2: 1st Costume deposit of \$35 per class (genre enrolled) will be added to invoice

TERM 3: 2nd Costume deposit of \$30 per class (genre enrolled). Subject to change depending on each costume and AUD conversion rates at the time of purchase.

TERM 4: Theatre Rehearsal & Showcase Fee (amount TBC) per student class (includes on stage rehearsal, whole showcase production video & presentation medal)

MISSED CLASSES

While missed classes are not refunded, make up classes may be scheduled if spots are available on other class days. Reflections Academy of Dance must be notified two [2] hours prior to missing your scheduled class and be pre-arranged by office staff. Make up classes must be taken in the current term and are limited to two (2) classes per term.

ENROLMENT

Enrolment to Reflections Academy of Dance is rolling for the following terms unless notified by email prior to the end of the previous term.

CONCERT

Our students are working towards our End of Year Concert and it is assumed that all students will participate in the concert. If you do not want your child to participate, you must notify us via email by the end of Term 2. Costumes will be purchased by Reflections Academy of Dance and invoiced closer to the Concert Date.
